OR
- Bachelor's degree or international equivalent and 2 years supply chain experience
OR
- Five years supply chain experience

CPIM Accelerated Courses

Class Procedures

Classes: Certification classes are designed to assist you with your preparation for CPIM, CSCP and CLTD certification examinations. Supply Chain Basics is an introductory class. All other classes are intended for people with either academic or on-the-job experience. Non CPIM/CSCP/CLTD courses are general education not certification courses.

Exam Credits: Credits for the CPIM/CSCP/CLTD exams are good for 6 months from the date of issue. Please do not request a credit until you are ready to sit for the examination.

Refunds: All refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis and will be awarded at the discretion of the VP of Education.

Retakes: If you have taken a review class from us in the past 12 months and have not passed the corresponding examination, you can retake the class at no charge, otherwise retakes are \$100. You will need to provide a copy of your APICS Colorado Chapter 81 class certificate and bring your book to class. Other re-take options will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Certificates of Completion: Certificates are awarded on the basis of attendance.

Computer-Based Testing (CBT) Registration at Pearson VUE Test Centers: Registration requires a minimum of 48 hours up to 90 days in advance. Exams will be offered six days a week. **Visit the APICS Web site at www.apics.org/certification to access a link to the secured Pearson VUE online registration site and obtain an Authorization to Test (ATT)**

CSCP/CLTD Exams: Eligibility application must be submitted and approved two weeks prior to registering for exam.
